Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus, forbearing the respondents 1 to 4 not to give extension to the fifth respondent from quarrying rough stones such as Aralai, jelly and sholing and such other materials in his patta lands in S.Nos.276/2, 277/2 and 278/A1 in an extent of about 0.40.5, 0.40.5, 1.65.0 hectares respectively in Aathur Village, Manmangalam Taluk, Karur District and consequently direct the first respondent to take serious action as per the law against the fifth respondent for violating the earlier licence condition for quarry within 7.5 meters from the petitioner's land based on the petitioner's representation dated 12.03.2018.
