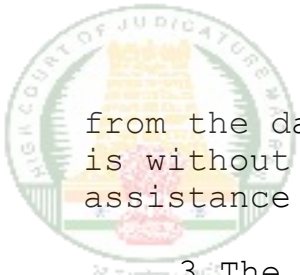

The petitioner wants the petition mentioned lands to be surveyed and measured.

2.The second and third respondents are directed to conclude the survey exercise. If the second and third respondents encountered any resistance, they shall relegate the writ petitioner to move the competent Civil Court. If there is no resistance of opposition, the survey exercise should be completed within a period of three months



from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. If the opposition is without any basis, the survey authority is at liberty to take the assistance of the jurisdictional police.

3. The writ petitioner is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
