PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to permit the petitioner to fill up the sanctioned vacancies of the Teaching Staff, namely, (1 Assistant Professor in English, 1 Assistant Professor in Tamil, 1 Assistant Professor in Hindi, 3 Assistant Professors in History, 4 Assistant Professor in Economics, 2 Assistant Professors in B.B.A., 4 Assistant Professors in Maths, 2 Assistant Professors in Chemistry, 4 Assistant Professor in Botany, 6 Assistant Professors in Zoology, 5 Assistant Professor in Geology and 5 Assistant Professors in Commerce) and the Non-teaching staff namely, (1 Junior Assistants, 1 Steno-Typist, 1 Record Clerk, 2 Museum keeper, 4 Lab Assistants, 8 Office Assistants, 2 Watchmen, 5 Sweeper, 1 Gardner, 2 Waterman, 1 Herbarium Keeper, 1 Library Assistant) and consequently, to release the grant-in-aid to the petitioner college within the time frame stipulated by this Court.

Giving for a direction to the respondents to permit the petitioner College to fill up the sanctioned vacancies of the



teaching and non-teaching staff and for a consequential direction to release the grant-in-aid to the petitioner college, the present writ petition has been filed.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing on both sides and perused the materials available on record.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner college has been sanctioned 120 teaching staff and 63 non-teaching staff by the authority concerned and praying for permission to fill up the vacancies pertaining to the non-teaching and teaching posts, the petitioner made representations, dated 07.11.2016, 23.12.2016, 01.09.2017 and 12.04.2018. However, the representations are kept pending without any progress, which has necessitated the filing of this writ petition.

4. The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents, on instructions, submitted that the representations of the petitioner would be considered on merits within the time stipulated by this Court.

5. Under such facts and circumstances of the case, this Court, without going into the merits of the case, directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 12.04.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. This writ petition is disposed of, on the above terms. No costs.
