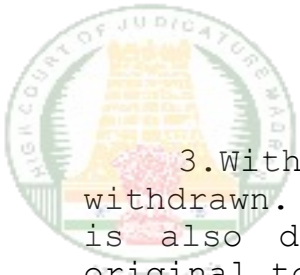

ORDER

3. With this liberty, this writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is also dismissed. Registry shall return the impugned order in original to the writ petitioner.
