2.The petitioner seeks issuance of legal heir certificate in respect of his mother.

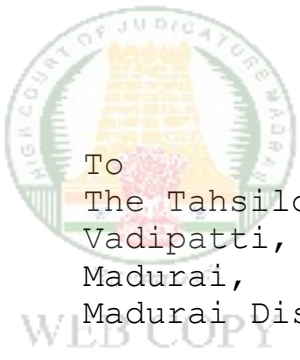
