PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the second respondent to change the EB service connection No.145-011-500 relating with the land, measuring 0.04.0 Ares, comprised in S.No.17/11B in Dakshinapuram Village, Alangudi Taluk in Pudukottai District from the name of the third respondent to the petitioner's name or in the joint name of the petitioner and the third respondent by disposing his representation dated 18.01.2019.

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner and the learned standing counsel appearing for R1 and R2.
