ORDER

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate for the respondent police,

The learned Government Advocate, on instructions, submits that sometime in the year 2015, there was some group clash among the community of the petitioner and therefore, separate cases were registered against the rival parties. However, it is now stated that on inspection, in the subsequent years several events have been conducted peacefully. He further submitted that the respondent police have no serious objection to grant permission to the petitioner to participate in the said festival.

4. The statement made by the learned Government Advocate is recorded.

5. Considering the submission made by the learned Government Advocate, the petitioner is permitted to participate in the festival of Arulmigu Kalliamman Thirukovil -Nilakottai on 17.03.2019 to 21.03.2019. With this direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
