The learned Government Advocate, on instructions, submits that sometime in the year 2015, there was some group clash with the community of the petitioner and separate cases were registered. However, it is now stated that on inspection in subsequent years events have been peacefully conducted. He further submitted that the respondent police have no serious objection to grant permission to the petitioner to participate in the said festival.
