ORDER

4.If such a complaint is filed before the Consumer Disputes Redressal Forum, the jurisdictional Forum is directed to dispose of the petitioner's complaint within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



5. Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
