The respondents are ready to carry out the work of survey based on the joint request of all the pattathars. But in this case, the petitioner alone has made request.



4. This Court is not in a position to grant the relief sought for. The writ petition is therefore dismissed. Ofcourse the petitioner is at liberty to renew his request for survey and demarcation after obtaining individual patta in his name. No costs.
