ORDER

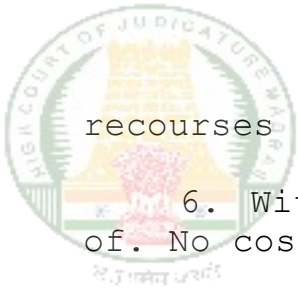
The present petition is filed seeking a direction to the second respondent to act on the complaint of the petitioner.
