ORDER

The petitioner seeks disbursement of educational loan. Heard the learned counsel on either side.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the respondent filed counter affidavit, in which it has been stated that the following particulars have been sought:-

- a) Hostel Fee Structure for the entire course period
- b) Income proof of co-applicant
- c) Account Statement of the co-applicant (SBI)
- d) Affidavit

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the particulars have already been given to the respondent.

4. But then this Court directs the petitioner to once again submit the aforementioned particulars to the respondent Bank. Upon receipt of the same, the respondent shall consider the petitioner's case and dispose it of in accordance with RBI norms within a period of three weeks.



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5. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of.
