O R D E R

This writ petition has been filed for a direction to the respondent to grant increment and arrears to the petitioner by considering his representation dated 20.07.2018 .

2.Heard both sides. By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3.According to the petitioner, although the punishment of stoppage of increment for a period of four years, awarded to him, was over a long back, he has not been granted further increment. His representation, in that regard, is kept pending without there being any orders passed. Hence, he is before this Court.

4.The learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent submitted the petitioner's representation would be considered on merits.
