ORDER

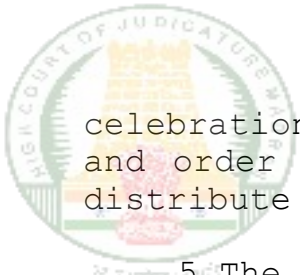
The present petition has been filed to direct the respondents to grant permission to the petitioner to celebrate his birthday at his residence on 04.04.2019, at Kattapulinar, Samayanallur, Madurai District.

2.Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondents.

3.The learned Government Advocate submitted that even though the petitioner has proposed to conduct his birthday celebration in his house, for which no permission is required, yet he had approached the second respondent and obtained a permission. Since permission is either not required or even if he considered it still is required and it has been obtained from the second respondent, nothing survives in this petition.
