2.The prayer made in this writ petition cannot be granted. The Honourable Supreme Court in the decision reported in **2016 (10) SCC 767 (Sathya Pal Anand Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh and others)** held that the competent authority to cancel the registration of the



document is only the Civil Court. Therefore granting liberty to the petitioner to move the jurisdictional Civil Court, this Writ Petition stands dismissed. It is made clear that this Court has not gone into the merits of the matter. No costs.
