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Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay the service Surrender Leave Salary of Rs.60,098/- payable to the petitioner for the period from May 2010 to May 2013 together with 18% interest from the date of her retirement ie. 29/02/2016 to till the date of payment and all other attendant to her.

COMMON ORDER

Seeking a direction to the respondents to pay service surrender leave salary, the petitioners are before this Court.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned counsel appearing for the respondents. By consent, the writ petitions are taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

3.The case of the petitioners is that they were employed as Senior Superintendents in the first respondent Corporation. They retired from service on 30.04.2016 and 29.02.2016 respectively. Since their service surrender leave salary have not yet been disbursed, these writ petitions have been filed.

4.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that this Court passed orders in similar circumstances in *WP(MD) No.12720 of 2018 [K.Saroja Vs. The Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation (Madurai) Ltd., Madurai]* wherein, this Court directed the respondent therein to disburse the amount mentioned therein within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of order. Hence, the learned counsel sought a similar order in these writ petitions as well.

6. In view of the above, the respondents are directed to disburse the amounts as claimed by the petitioners, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
