ORDER

2.Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the



respondents.

3.The learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that one individual is trying to hold out threat and trying to obstruct the festival with his associates in the private temple.

4.The learned Government Advocate, on instructions, submitted that the representation of the petitioner would be duly considered by the respondents.

5.In view of the said statement, the second respondent is directed to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 29.03.2019 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law.

6.With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
