3.It is the submission of the learned Additional Government Pleader that one Selvaraj with the aid of the petitioner has committed dacoity and robbery, who has involved in more than 46 cases and based on the confession statements and the reliable information, the investigation agency conducted a search in the house of the petitioner and also recovered stolen properties.

4.Considering the said submissions, we are of the view that this writ petition is liable to be dismissed on the grounds that it is premature and there are no merits. Hence, the petitioner does not deserve any order in this writ petition.
