**COMMON ORDER**

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard to the limited scope of the prayer, sought for herein, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the petitioners' case, directs the respondents to consider the respective representations of the petitioners dated 12.03.2019, 18.03.2019 and 14.03.2019 on merits and in accordance with law, and pass appropriate orders, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

4. With the above direction, these writ petitions are disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.

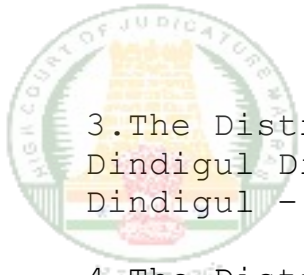
