At this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the petition and to file a petition under Section 167(ii) of Cr.P.C before the trial court and he submits that due to pendency of the above petition, he is unable to file the statutory bail application before the trial court.



4. In view of the submission and endorsement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn and the trial court shall entertain the bail petition under section 167(ii) of Cr.P.C, if it is otherwise in order.
