Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to refix the petitioner's scale of pay and pension by way of fixing the Grade Pay as Rs.5,400/- with monetary benefits with effect from 01.04.2013 in the light of the Judgment of this Court in W.P(MD)No.2654 of 2018, dated 19.03.2018 within the time stipulated by this Court.

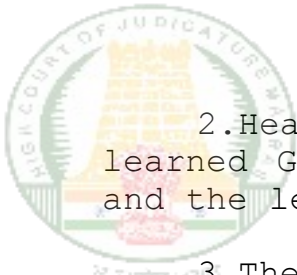

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of a writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to refix the Grade Pay and pension of the petitioner.



2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents 1 to 4 and the learned counsel appearing for the fifth respondent.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was appointed as Vocational Instructor on 01.04.1990 and retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.05.2017. Though the petitioner received Grade Pay of Rs.5,400/- till the date of his retirement, after his retirement, Grade Pay was refixed as Rs.4,800/-. Hence, the petitioner made a representation to the respondents on 26.03.2018 in this regard. Since the same has not been considered by the respondents, the petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition.

4. The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents 1 to 4 submitted that the prayer of the petitioner would be considered as per G.O.Ms.No.306, Finance (CMPC) Department, dated 12.09.2018 and seeks two months time for considering the claim of the petitioner.

5. In such view of the matter, this Court, without going into the merits of the petitioner's claim, directs the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 26.03.2018 seeking for re-fixation of Grade Pay and pension in the light of G.O.Ms.No.306, Finance (CMPC) Department, dated 12.09.2018 and also in the light order passed by this Court in W.P(MD)No.2654 of 2018, dated 19.03.2018 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. Such an exercise shall be completed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
