O R D E R

This Criminal Original petition has been filed to transfer the case in M.C.No.14 of 2018 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Periyakulam to Family Court, Dindigul.

2. The matter has been referred before the Mediation Centre and the parties have amicably settled the issue. They also executed settlement agreement . The relevant portion of the settle agreement dated 18.03.2019 reads as follows:

"1. The petitioner/husband has agreed to pay Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs only) as full and final settlement towards permanent alimony to his daughter namely k.Kanika Sri through two Demand Drafts each for Rs.5,00,000/- (D.D.Nos.289752 and 289753) dated 15.03.2019 drawn on State Bank of India, Trichy

2. The Respondent/Wife has agreed to accept the above Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs only) as permanent alimony for her daughter and further undertakes that either she or her daughter the 1st respondent herein will not make any claim as against the petitioner/husband/father or his parents either by way of maintenance or as against their property

3. The Respondent/Wife has agreed that she

will not file any appeal as against the decree



passed in HMOP No.192 of 2014 dated 11.05.2018 on the file of the Family Court, Dindigul

4. Both parties further undertakes that they will not make any complaint as against each other or against their parents. And if any complaints already made both parties undertakes to withdraw all the complaint".

3. Accordingly the Criminal Original Petition stands closed and the settlement agreement dated 18.03.2019 shall form part and parcel of the order. Consequently connected miscellaneous petition is also closed.
