3. The learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) would point out that the petitioner along with others collected Rs.15,000/- each from 300 persons and issued bogus patta.



4. Taking note of the serious allegation made against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant any relief. The Criminal Original petition stands dismissed.
