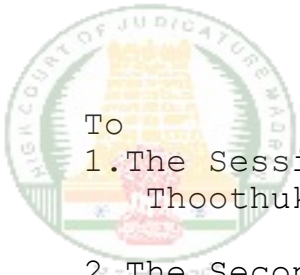
2. Recording the aforesaid statement made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
