The detenu himself is the petitioner and challenging the legality of the impugned order of detention dated 01.03.2019, passed by the second respondent, under Section 3(1) of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Drug-offenders, Forest-offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 (Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982) and branding him as 'Goonda' in No.16/BCDFGISSSV/2019, came forward to file the present Habeas
