The petitioner is very much concerned with the wellbeing and whereabouts of her husband and therefore, she has come forward to file this Habeas Corpus Petition.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to produce materials as to the marriage between the petitioner and the detenu.
