PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 19.02.2015 and 08.06.2015 in the light of the direction issued by the office of the first respondent vide Na.Ka.No.482/2014/Tho.Ve.Sa.4 dated 07.04.2015 and consequently directing the fourth respondent to disburse the retirement benefit payable to him with interest at the rate of 18% per annum till the date of realization.

**ORDER**

The writ petition is filed against a Cooperative Society. The writ petitioner was an employee in the fourth respondent / Cooperative Society. The grievance of the writ petitioner is that the terminal and retirement benefits were not settled to her.

2. Though the writ petitioner has to exhaust the remedy under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Cooperative Societies Act, 1983 (hereinafter, referred to as "the Act"), the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents brought to the notice of this Court that the fourth respondent / Cooperative Society has already settled the terminal and pensionary benefits of the writ petitioner as detailed below:

3. In view of the fact that the grievance of the writ petitioner has already been redressed, no further adjudication is required in respect of the grounds raised in the present writ petition. 4. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
