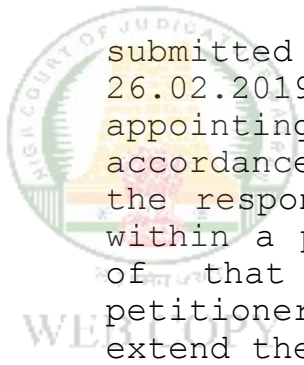
Prayer in WP(MD) . 3733 of 2019 :
