PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of certiorarified mandamus to call for the records relating to the order passed by the 1st respondent vide proceedings in Letter PNT.1/6756/2011 dated 09.01.2015 and quash the same as illegal and consequently direct the respondents to give promotion to the petitioner as Junior Assistant following with other benefits with retrospective effect from the date of initial promotion on 29.01.1974 by waiving the reversion period from 29.01.1974 to 31.08.1979 on a par with other employees appointed as Junior Assistants who have not possessed basic qualification based on the petitioner's representation dated 20.01.2012.
