PRAYER: This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuing a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the entire records pertaining to the order of suspension that has been passed by the respondent vide his proceeding in File No.M-25/02/2017-Estt/848 dated 03.08.2018 as well as his extended order of suspension through his Order No.M-25/02/2017-Estt/57 Dated 23.01.2019 and quash the same and consequently direct the respondent to reinstate the petitioner in the service so as to serve as Lascar at Marine Department, V.O. Chidambaranar Port Trust, Thoothukudi.
