2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Government Advocate for the respondents 1 and 2 and the learned standing counsel for the third respondent.

Today, when the writ petition is taken up for hearing, the learned standing counsel appearing for the third respondent Insurance Company submits that, the entire amount, as has been sought for by the petitioner has been deposited.
