



petitioner is satisfied if the first respondent is directed to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation/appeal dated 18.03.2019, within the time frame to be fixed by this Court.

3. The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the respondents submitted that the particulars as sought by the first respondent have been produced by the third respondent vide the proceedings dated -03.2019 in Na.Ka.No.16285/2017/A2 and therefore, the representation of the petitioner will be considered by the first respondent and appropriate orders be passed. A copy of the proceedings dated -03.2019 in Na.Ka.No.16285/2017/A2 has been produced before the Court for perusal.

4. In view of the submissions made on either side and considering the limited scope of the prayer now sought for by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, directs the first respondent to consider the petitioner's representation/appeal dated 18.03.2019 and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. The Writ Petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs. Consequently, WMP(MD)No.6732 of 2019 is closed.
