PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to absorb the petitioners as Assistant Engineer (AE) w.e.f the date on which their junior viz., M.Ravi was absorbed in service on 07.01.2008 by counting the past service rendered by the petitioners in AGROFED as Block Manager with continuity of service and all other attended monetary benefits in the light of order made in S.L.P.No.12121/2011 dated 11.05.2016 and by considering the representation dated 10.06.2017 and 03.11.2017 within the period that may be stipulated by this Court.

ORDER

3.Though the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners has raised various grounds in the present writ petition, when the matter is taken up for hearing, he submitted that it would suffice, if a direction is issued to the respondent to consider the representation of the petitioners dated 10.06.2017.
