Prayer:: Civil Miscellaneous Appeal filed under section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, against the award and decree passed in M.C.O.P. No.344 of 2014, dated 06/07/2018 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Special District Judge, Madurai.

Order:This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal coming up for hearing on this day; upon perusing the grounds of Appeal, the award of the Tribunal and the material papers to this case and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. N. 1.That the compensation awarded under the award and decree of the Tribunal below be and hereby is enhanced from Rs.4,81,000/- (Rupees four lakhs Eighty one thousand only) to a sum of Rs.7,11,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Eleven thousand only)along with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from
