COMMON ORDER

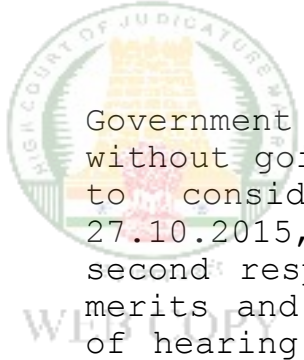
These Writ Petitions have been filed, seeking to direct respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners as per G.O.Ms.No.1426 Home (Pol.XV) Department, dated 11.10.2007 and to pay the regular time scale of pay of Rs.4,800/- - 10000/- + Grade pay Rs.1,300/- as per the proceedings of the 2nd respondent in RC.No.168346/NGB 6(1) 2011, dated 21.05.2013 and to pay the monetary benefits to them.

2. The grievance of the petitioners is that though the second respondent has recommended to the first respondent by its letter, dated 21.05.2013 to regularize the services of the petitioners as per G.O.Ms.No.110, dated 17.03.2011, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the petitioners have sent representations and the same are still pending, without consideration. Hence, these Writ Petitions.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents, who on instructions, submitted that the representations of the petitioners would be considered in line with the proceedings passed by the second respondent, dated 21.05.2013.
