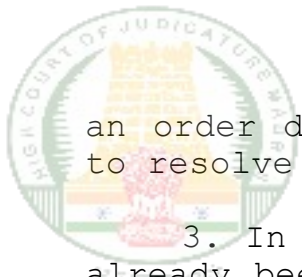

This writ petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 04.08.2017, for giving police protection to the petitioner Pallivasal.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor on instructions would submit that there is a dispute between two groups with regard to run the Management of the Wake and it is a civil dispute and the second respondent has already considered the representation of the petitioner and passed



an order directing the parties to approach the Revenue authorities to resolve the dispute.
