This writ petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the respondents to take appropriate action on the petitioner's complaint dated 04.08.2017 and register the F.I.R.

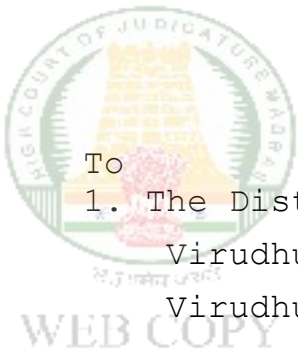
