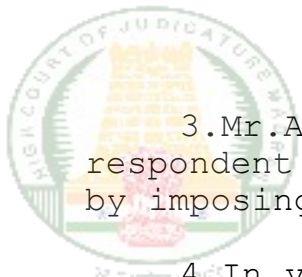
PRAYER IN CRL RC(MD) .NO.SR.20223 of 2019:-
