4.Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought in the writ petition, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, directs the third respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 27.06.2019 and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law on or before 13.07.2019.
