ORDER

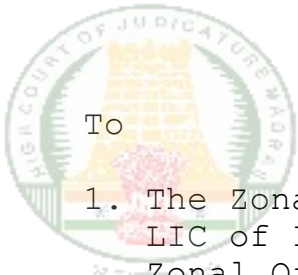
The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Counsel appearing for the respondents submitted that the matter has become infructuous and hence nothing survives for adjudication.
