O R D E R

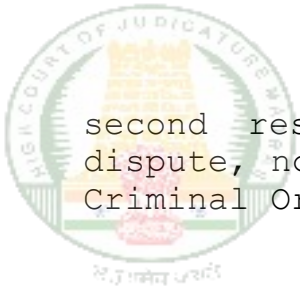
The criminal original petition has been filed seeking a direction to the first respondent not to harass the petitioner and his family members under the guise of enquiry.
