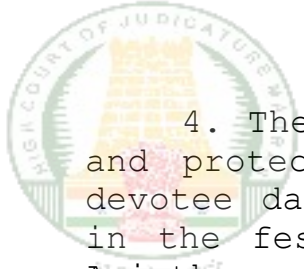

The grievance of the petitioner is that seeking permission and protection to conduct the Adal Padal and other devotee dance programme on 27.07.2019 at 07.00 p.m. to 12.00 a.m in the festival of Arulmighu Sri Agasa Kaliyamman Thirukovil at Amirthapuram, Kandramanickam Post.
