Considering the submissions made by the learned Counsel on either side, the petitioner is granted liberty to file appropriate representation before the respondents within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. On such filing, the same shall be considered by the respondents and appropriate orders be passed on merits and in accordance with law, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within a period of four weeks thereafter.

4. The Writ Petition stands disposed of with the above direction. No costs.

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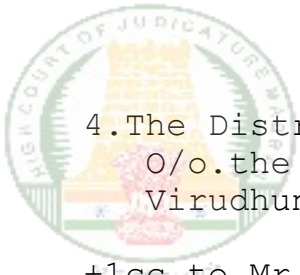
