Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to revise the pension benefits and other revised terminal benefits like Gratuity Arrears, Leave Salary Arrears and Pension Arrears, etc and payment of the monetary benefit with effect from 01.10.017 to till the date of payment at the rate of 12% per annum payable for the said monetary benefits based on the 7th Pay commission on the base of 250st Board meeting dated 28.08.2018 passed a resolution in Resolution No.58/2018-19, as per G.O.Ms.No.134, Transport (D) Dept. Dated 09.04.2018.
