ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the second respondent to issue compensation of Rs.1,76,386/- with interest to the petitioner in the light of the petitioner's representation dated 22.06.2019.

2.Mr.M.Pandiarajan, learned Additional Government Pleader takes notice for the respondents 1 and 2. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that with reference to the prayer sought for in this writ petition, the
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petitioner sent a representation to the second respondent on 22.06.2019. But, no action has been taken till date. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court for the relief stated supra.

4. In reply, the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 would submit that the petitioner's representation dated 22.06.2019, would be considered on merits and in accordance with law, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

5. In agreement with the submission made by the learned Additional Government Pleader, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 22.06.2019, and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
