ORDER

4.Recording the abovesaid submission made by the learned Additional Government Pleader, without going into the merits of the case, this Court directs the first respondent to dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 28.06.2019, on merits and in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
