PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.93 of 2019 on the file of
the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections
294(b), 406, 420 and 506(i) of IPC, in Crime No.93 of 2019, seeks
anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent.

3.The petitioner is said to have borrowed a certain some of
money from the de-facto complainant. But, he has not returned
within the promised time. Thereafter, he issued a cheque, which was
dishonored on presentation. It appears that this is only a civil
dispute between the petitioner and de-facto complainant.



4. Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Eraniel and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
