Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the second respondent is directed to conduct enquiry upon the complaint given by the petitioner and after affording an opportunity of hearing to both the *de facto* complainant and the third respondent, shall pass orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of four(04) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
