Prayer: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to grant permission and protection for cultural event namely Adalpadal Scheduled to be held on 06.09.2019 at night 07.00 p.m. to 12.00 a.m. in connection with "Aavani Festival" in Arulmigu Sri Kamatchiamman Kovil at Kadavakottai Village, Avudaiyarkovil Taluk, Pudukkottai District, based on the petitioner's representation dated 20.08.2019.

The grievance of the petitioner is that seeking permission to conduct the "Adalpadal" Scheduled to be held on 06.09.2019 at night 07.00 p.m. to 12.00 a.m. in connection with "Aavani Festival" in Arulmigu Sri Kamatchiamman Kovil at Kadavakottai Village, Avudaiyarkovil Taluk, Pudukkottai District, the petitioner made a representation on 20.08.2019 to the respondents and the said representation was not considered so far. Hence, the present Writ Petition has been filed for the aforesaid relief.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the case, the second respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 20.08.2019 and pass suitable orders on merits and in accordance with law, forthwith.

6. The Writ Petition stands disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
