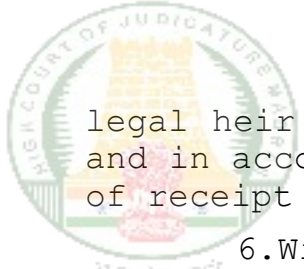

In order to obtain legal heir certificate for the deceased brother of the petitioner, the petitioner had given an online application on 13.07.2019 to the respondent and an acknowledgement to that effect also has been issued by the respondent. However, the same so far has not been considered. Therefore, the petitioner is before this Court.

Heard the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent, who would submit that, the said application submitted by the petitioner through online for getting legal heir certificate would be decided on merits and in accordance with law, within a time frame to be stipulated by this Court.

5. Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for in this Writ petition and with the consent of both sides, this Writ petition is disposed of at the admission stage with the following direction:
